Mining Claim Filing Requirements in Nevada as of July 7, 2014

An annual filing must be made for each lode or placer claim and each mill or tunnel site with:

		<u>County Recorder</u>	<u>U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Nevada State Office</u>
1	Filing Due:	<u>on or before November 1</u> of each year	<u>New Claims and Claim Maintenance Fees:</u> <u>on or before September 1</u> of each year <u>Annual Assessment Work: on or before December 30</u> of calendar year in which the assessment year ends.
2	New Claims:	Certificate of Location (for appropriate claim type) AND Claim Map	- Submit the forms filed with the County Recorder. - Call or write the BLM for total fees due.
	Renewal with assessment work performed on the claim, then file:	Affidavit of Annual Assessment Work	BLM Affidavit of Annual Assessment Work Form 3830-4 AND BLM Maintenance Fee Waiver Certification Form 3830-2 (aka Small Miner Exemption)
	Renewal with claim maintenance fees paid, then file:	Affidavit and Notice of Intent to Hold Mining Claim(s) and Site(s)	BLM Maintenance Fee Payment Form 3830-5 or 3830-5a (depending on the claim type)

New Claims Fee: \$155.00(*) plus processing and locations fees Claim Maintenance Fee: \$155.00(*) per lode claim \$155.00(*) per 20 acres placer up to 160 acres Other Forms: may have processing fees (*) Paid to the U.S. Bureau of Land Management, Nevada State Office
