JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Possess a valid driver's license
- Can work in all weather conditions
- Capable of lifting at least 50 lbs and hiking over uneven desert terrain and conditions
- Up to 13 weeks of employment, mostly Mon-Fri with some longer weeks (tentative schedule: 5/19 - 8/15/2025)
- Expect regular and overtime wages, as field days will often be 12 hours and weekly totals may exceed 40 hrs/wk
- Must be able to work well alone, with a partner and in small groups
- Must be able to work & camp in remote areas lacking amenities
- Must be responsible and demonstrate a 'safety-first' work ethic at all times
- Job is based out of Carson City for the duration of employment, the Division will not cover relocation costs

Expected salary is \$19.50/hr with up to 20 hours of overtime per week. Interns also receive a \$40/night camping rate \$68+/day per diem. Application closeout date: 2/21/2024
